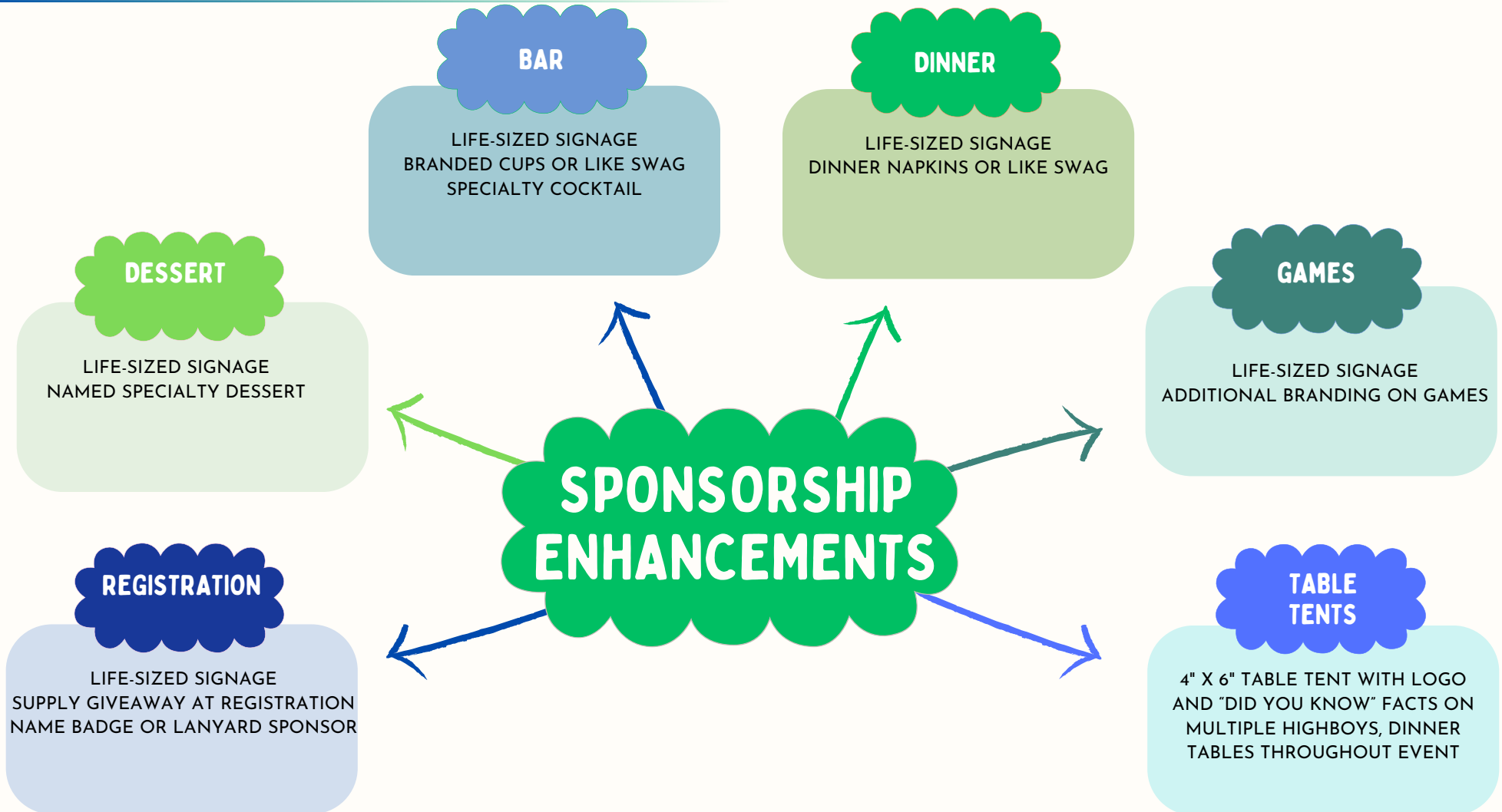

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# STATEMENT ON POLITICAL ACTIVITY

The Neighborhood Building Owners Alliance (NBOA) is organized under Section 501(c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code.

NBOA is a coalition of neighborhood housing organizations and individual housing providers. We advocate on behalf of our affiliate organizations and all small and medium-sized housing providers. We operate a year-round public relations campaign for our industry, working to improve the perception of housing providers. Through our political advocacy, we engage and educate elected officials and government employees about our members and we fight unfavorable and counterproductive legislation and public policy.

Your contribution will be deposited into our general operating account, which is not registered as a political committee under federal or state election law and does not make independent expenditures or make contributions or other expenditures to candidate campaigns, political party committees, or other organizations registered as political committees that could require it to register as a political committee under any federal, state or local election law;

The general operating account is not used either directly or indirectly for such purposes, such as transferring your contribution to another organization or account that engages in the above activity;

The general operating account has not been established and is not maintained, financed, or controlled by a national, state, or local party committee or a federal, state, or local candidate campaign;

The general operating account does not coordinate its activities with a national, state, or local party committee; federal, state or local candidate campaign; or a federal, state, or local PAC;

Your donation to the general operating account will not be used in any way that is directly or indirectly prohibited under applicable federal, state, or local law. This includes, but is not limited to, activity engaged in through direct expenditures by the organization or through arrangements with third parties; and

Your contribution to the general operating account will not be used to pay for any expenses or events that violate applicable gift and entertainment rules for public officials. NBOA-PAC is organized to support candidate campaigns and other political organizations. NBOA's General Fund is not used for this purpose.

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
